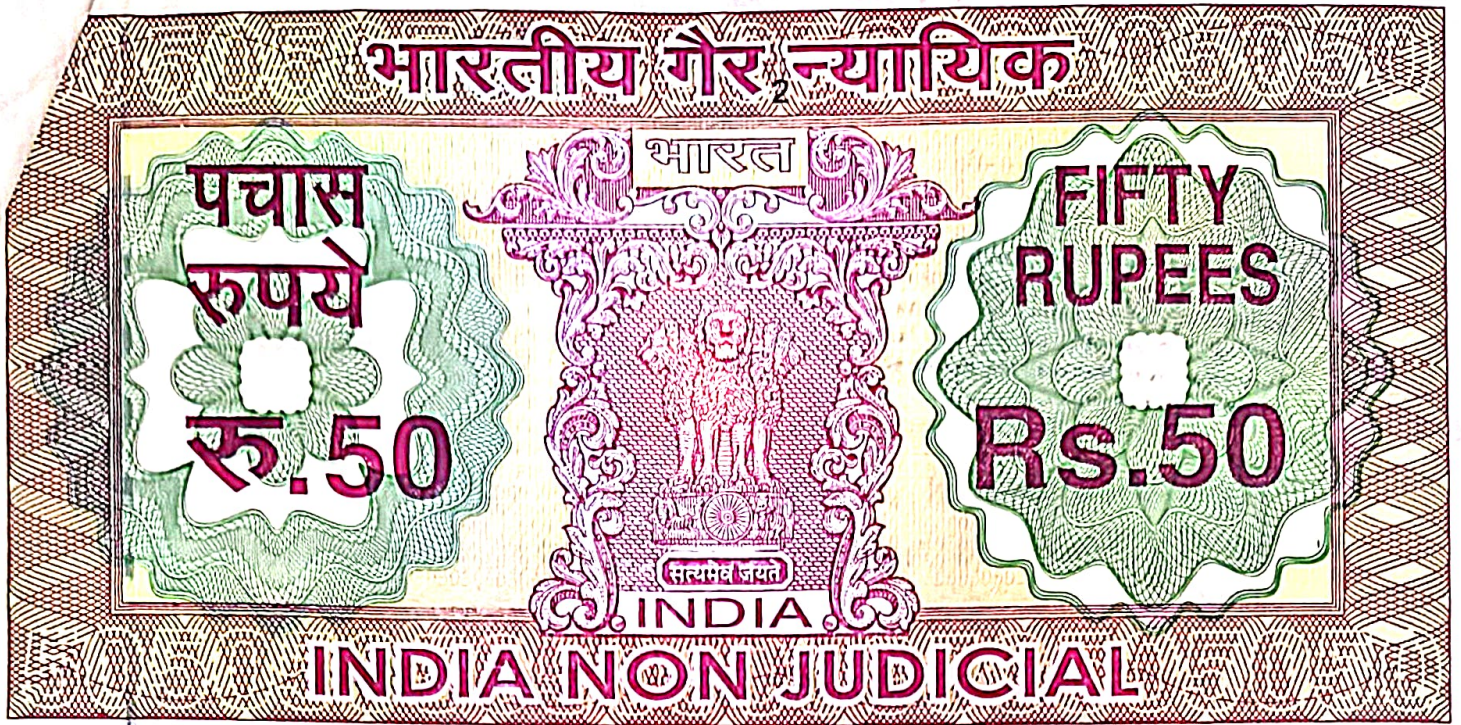

This Deed of Declaration of Trust is made and executed on this Seventeen day of November, Two Thousand Twenty-Five.

## PARTIES TO THE DEED

### I. THE SETTLOR

Bikash Prasad Yadav, son of Lakshman Prasad Yadav, residing at 72/1 Topsia Road South, Kolkata 700046 (hereinafter referred to as the "Settlor" or "President," which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include his heirs, executors, administrators, and legal representatives).

### II. THE TRUSTEES

(The Settlor and the Trustees are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Trustees" or "Board of Trustees," which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include their survivors and successor-in-office.)

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS the Settlor is desirous of establishing a Public Charitable Trust for the objects and purposes set forth hereinafter.

WHEREAS the Settlor has transferred a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only)** (the initial Corpus) to the Trustees for the purpose of the Trust, and the Trustees hereby accept the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Deed WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY DECLARED as follows:

1. Trust Name, Office, and Date of Commencement

1.1. Name: The name of the Trust shall be **EDU HUNGER FOUNDATION.**

1.2. Registered Office (Address): The Principal Office of the Trust shall be located at 3/16 Sapgachi 2nd Lane, Kolkata 700039, or such other place in India as the Trustees may decide from time to time.

1.3. Date of Commencement: The date of commencement of this Trust shall be the date of execution of this Trust Deed that is 17<sup>th</sup> of November 2025

## 2. Aims and Main Objectives of the Trust

The primary and main objects for which the Trust is established are for the benefit of the public at large, without discrimination of caste, creed, or religion, specifically focusing on social welfare and attracting Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds:

a. Education (SDG 4 - Quality Education): To establish, run, maintain, or assist schools, colleges, educational institutions, coaching centers, skill development centers, libraries, and vocational training institutes for the promotion of education and literacy, particularly among economically backward classes, women, and physically challenged persons.

b. Hunger and Health (SDG 2 - Zero Hunger & SDG 3 - Good Health): To undertake, promote, or support activities for the alleviation of hunger, malnutrition, and poverty, including the establishment of community

kitchens, food distribution programs, and providing nutritious meals to the needy.

c. Social Harmony and Welfare: To provide humanitarian aid and relief in times of natural calamities, and to promote social cohesion, communal harmony, and national integration among different communities. This includes supporting cultural events of public benefit, strictly ensuring that no activity promotes the interests of any particular religious sect or group over others, maintaining absolute secular character for public charity status.

### 3. Other Objectives (Activities for NGO Scope)

To carry out all other activities that an NGO can legitimately pursue, including:

- a. To purchase, acquire, or hold movable and immovable properties of any kind for the Trust's purposes.
- b. To receive grants, donations, contributions, subscriptions, and gifts in cash or in kind from any person, institution, Central/State Governments, or any funding agency, including foreign contributions, provided necessary Government clearances are obtained.
- c. To publish, distribute, and sell books, pamphlets, journals, and periodicals to spread awareness of the Trust's objects.

d. To collaborate with other NGOs, charitable organizations, or corporate bodies to achieve common objectives.

#### 4. Other Social Objective

a. To provide relief and rehabilitation to victims of floods, earthquakes, fire, and other natural or man-made disasters.

b. To work towards environmental protection, promotion of clean water, and sanitation facilities.

c. To work for the welfare and rehabilitation of senior citizens, orphans, and destitute persons.

#### 5. Other General Objective of the Public Utility

a. To engage in any other acts or deeds which may be beneficial to the general public, provided the same are charitable in nature.

b. To undertake activities for the improvement of public amenities and civic infrastructure.

c. To manage the Trust corpus and properties effectively and prudently for sustained charitable activities.

#### 6. Constitution of the Trust

The Trust shall consist of not less than two (2) and not more than seven (7) Trustees. The Settlor, Bikash Prasad

Yadav, shall be the First President, and Abhishek Kumar Ray shall be the First Trustee.

#### 7. Office Bearer of the Trust

The Trustees shall elect from amongst themselves the following Office Bearers:

- a. President: Bikash Prasad Yadav shall be the first President. The President shall preside over all meetings, supervise the working of the Trust, and shall be the principal executive authority.
- b. Trustee/Secretary: Abhishek Kumar Ray shall be the first Trustee/Secretary. The Secretary shall be responsible for the day-to-day affairs, maintaining records, and correspondence.
- c. Changes: Any changes in the Office Bearers, including the appointment of new Office Bearers or the retirement of existing ones, shall be effected by the mutual consent of the majority of the existing Trustees, recorded in the minutes of the meeting.

#### 8. Investment in favour of NGO ✓

All investments of the Trust funds shall be made in such modes and forms as are specified in Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as amended from time to time, to ensure the continuation of its charitable status and

exemption benefits. No funds shall be invested in any speculative or unapproved commercial venture.

#### 9. Functions of the Trust

1. The Trust will never act which are illegal and unlawful in nature and also oppose to the Public Policy & contrary to the law of the country. In connection with sec 4 for which the trust and the trustees are responsible for that and come under the all punishable law (CRPC and IPC).
2. The Trust will never acts like Micro Financing, Micro Credit, Franchisee and Money laundering (Act-2012) Economic offence/crime and in nature and shall not obtain any donation of like abroad without getting the permission under FCRA FROM THE Central Govt. the competent Govt. Authority which the trust and the trustees are responsible for and the whole trust is void and come under the all punishable laws.
3. The Trust shall never borrow and or augment money from the public or open market by announcing attractive financial investment scheme.
4. All donation and gift from any individual or institution or any concern shall be accepted by maintaining all legal norms and valid documents/receipts.

## 10. Power of the Trustee

The Trustees shall have the power to:

- a. Raise funds by way of subscriptions, donations, grants, and any other lawful means.
- b. Appoint a Managing Committee or Sub-Committees for specific tasks, and delegate powers to them.
- c. Enter into contracts, agreements, and collaborations necessary for the objects of the Trust.
- d. Institute, conduct, defend, compromise, or abandon any legal proceedings concerning the Trust.

## 11. Banking Account

The Bank Account(s) of the Trust shall be opened and maintained with such scheduled bank(s) as the Trustees may decide. The accounts shall be operated jointly by the President (Bikash Prasad Yadav) along with one of the Trustees (Abhishek Kumar Ray) or any two designated Trustees/Office Bearers as mutually consented by the Board.

## 12. Funds of the Trust

The funds of the Trust shall consist of:

- a. The Initial Corpus contributed by the Settlor.

- b. Voluntary contributions, donations, gifts, and grants received from time to time.
- c. Income derived from the properties and investments of the Trust.
- d. Funds received from CSR activities, government agencies, and foreign contributions (subject to FCRA compliance).

### 13. Accounts and Audit

The Trustees shall maintain proper books of account of all the assets, liabilities, income, and expenditure of the Trust in accordance with standard accounting principles.

### 14. Irrevocable

The Trust hereby created shall be IRREVOCABLE.

### 15. Amalgamation

The Trustees shall have the power to amalgamate the Trust with any other Trust or Institution having similar objects, provided such other Trust or Institution is registered under Section 12A and approved under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961, and the scheme of amalgamation is approved by the concerned authority.

### 16. Winding Up

In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust, the assets remaining after the satisfaction of all debts and liabilities shall not be distributed among the Trustees but shall be transferred to another institution having similar objects and registered under Section 12A and approved under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

#### 17. Maintenance and Audit of Account

The accounts shall be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant duly appointed by the Trustees. The audited financial statements shall be placed before the Board of Trustees for approval and compliance with all statutory requirements, including filing with the Income Tax Department and Registrar of Assurances.

#### 18. Suit and Legal Proceedings

The Trust shall sue and be sued in the name of the Trust through the President or any Trustee authorized by a resolution of the Board of Trustees.

#### 19. Alteration of Trust Deed and Regulations / Amendments

The Trustees shall have the power to amend, alter, or add to any of the clauses, rules, or regulations of the

Trust Deed by a resolution passed by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the total number of Trustees, provided that:

- a. Such alteration does not change the fundamental charitable and public utility nature of the Trust.
- b. Such alteration is not repugnant to the provisions of the Indian Trusts Act, 1882, or the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- c. The Trust shall remain irrevocable.

#### 20. Immovable Properties of the Trust

All immovable properties acquired by the Trust shall be vested in the name of the Trust. The Trustees shall have the power to manage, mortgage, sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of such properties for the advancement of the Trust's objects, provided that any such major transaction shall require a resolution of the Board of Trustees.

#### 21. Amendments of the Scheme

The Board of Trustees is empowered to make rules and regulations for the conduct of the business and administration of the Trust, and to amend, vary, or cancel the same from time to time, provided such amendments are consistent with the objects of the Trust Deed.

## 22. Applicability of the Indian Trusts Act, 1882

In all matters not specifically provided for in this Deed, the provisions of the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 (as amended from time to time) shall apply, mutatis mutandis.

## 23. Lawful Purpose

The entire purpose of the Trust is solely charitable, non-profit, and for public utility, operating within the framework of the laws of India.

## 24. Applicability of Income Tax Act, 1961

The Trust shall comply with all the requirements of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as amended from time to time, including but not limited to registration under Section 12A and seeking approval under Section 80G, to avail tax exemptions and benefits for itself and its donors. The income and property of the Trust, however derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects set forth herein.

## 25. Appointment of New Trustee

A new Trustee may be appointed by a majority resolution of the existing Trustees in the event of death, resignation, retirement, or removal of any Trustee,

provided the total number of Trustees remains within the prescribed limits (2 to 7).

#### 26. Delegation of Power

The Board of Trustees may, by resolution, delegate any of its powers to the President, Secretary, or any other Trustee or Committee for the smooth and efficient management of the Trust, provided such delegation is properly recorded and revocable at any time by the Board.

#### **SCHEDULE**

The trust has no movable and immovable, landed property except the trust value amounting Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten thousand only) in its own name and no immovable and landed property is being settled in favour of this trust by this documentation.
